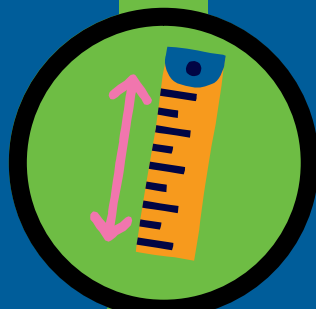


ATTIC INSULATION GUIDE

1 ASSESS YOUR ATTIC

- Measure the area of your attic to determine the amount of insulation needed.
- Identify any existing insulation and assess its condition.



2 DETERMINE ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS

- Check the eligibility criteria for each rebate program.
- Understand the documentation, application process, and deadlines to qualify for rebates.

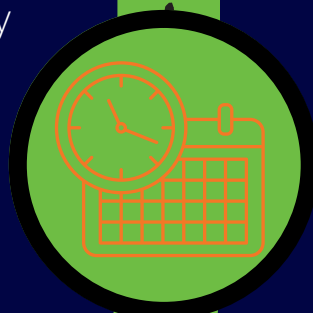
3 CHOOSE THE RIGHT INSULATION TYPE

- Consider different insulation options such as fiberglass, cellulose, or spray foam.
- Evaluate their R-value (thermal resistance) and suitability for your attic space.



4 SCHEDULE A HOME ENERGY AUDIT

- Contact a local energy efficiency program or utility company to schedule a home energy audit.
- A professional will assess your home's energy efficiency and insulation needs.



5 CONSULT WITH INSULATION CONTRACTORS

- Reach out to insulation contractors in your area for estimates and recommendations.
- Discuss the available rebate programs and ensure they are knowledgeable about the application process.
